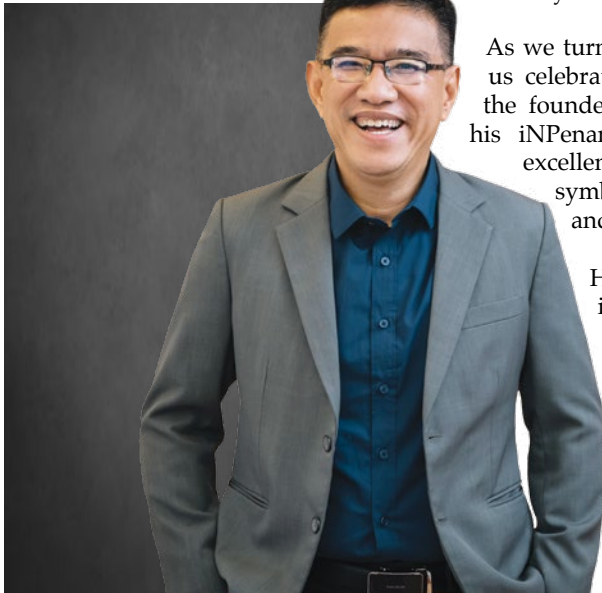

While visiting, do seize the opportunity to taste this captivating fruit. Yet, a word of caution: its unique texture and flavour have sparked debates among visitors, leading to its ban in numerous accommodations and public spaces.

Only the adventurous can truly appreciate why the durian earns its regal title.



MAO SHAN WANG

(a.k.a. *MUSANG KING*)

The cream of the crop! Adored for its rich, bittersweet taste and strong aroma, it boasts a firm outer flesh and a creamy core that durian lovers can't resist.

XO

Experience a unique aftertaste! Known for its soft texture and a distinct, almost alcoholic bitterness, the XO stands out among durian varieties.

HOR LOR

Indulge in a creamy bite! Its plush, thick flesh is a blend of creamy texture and sweet flavour, making it a memorable choice for durian aficionados.

GOLDEN PHOENIX

(a.k.a. *JIN FENG*)

For those who prefer a bitter edge! This variant is lighter and subtly scented, offering a creamy yet bitter taste with a softer consistency.

RED PRAWN

(a.k.a. *ANG HEA*)

A sweet delight! This variety, with its orangey-reddish hue, offers a sweet finish and a sticky, creamy texture that's unlike any other.

D24

(a.k.a. *SULTAN*)

A symbol of Penang's pride! Celebrated for its dense, succulent flesh and a perfect mix of sweet and bitter, the D24 is a must-try.

What began as a series of arts and cultural events held to commemorate George Town's inscription as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and its Outstanding Universal Value in 2008, the George Town Festival (GTF) has morphed into one of the region's flagship cultural events, attracting participants and performers locally and from around the globe. This annual event takes place every July, in conjunction with George Town World Heritage Day.

As a platform that encourages development of the arts while rejuvenating both used and unused spaces in the George Town UNESCO World Heritage Site, GTF also seeks to actively engage the local community in making meaningful connections to the heritage site, helping to preserve and revitalise both living heritage and built heritage.

It also celebrates the city's richness and diversity in arts, culture, and heritage with each year's programme through world-class performances and installations with collaborations and partnerships from international and local artists, local businesses and communities.

The festival has earned strong brand recognition and international media attention, putting George Town on the map for all art enthusiasts, promoters, and patrons, allowing them to discover, explore, and appreciate this city's cultural heritage which has been more than 200 years in the making.

This year sees the fifteenth edition of the GTF, spanning ten days from 19 to 28 July 2024, and will be managed and curated by Kerson Media Global Sdn. Bhd, focusing on the theme "HERE & NOW".

Gurney Bay, (formerly known as Gurney Wharf) is the new iconic seafront park in Penang, located off Gurney Drive.

Spanning 24.28 hectares of reclaimed land, this milestone project is a Penang State Government initiative, valued at RM247.8 million. Envisioned as a prominent waterfront destination for Penang, it is designed with four distinct recreational zones - a beach, a coastal grove, a water garden and a lifestyle area.

Phase One, also known as Priority 1, recently opened to the public, offering a 27.70-acre expanse of attractions including a children's play area, skate park, public toilets, pedestrian promenade, hawker stalls, retail areas, recreation park, hawker kiosks, open car park space, and a south water body reclamation area. A standout feature is its sea-fronting promenade, providing visitors panoramic views of the Penang coastline. Phase One has been enhanced with the planting of 1,500 trees and approximately 10,000 shrubs.



More to Come

Priority 2, covering 74.10 acres, will further enrich Gurney Bay with additional amenities such as a hawker centre, retail area, convenience stores, north viewing deck, public toilets, hawker kiosks, multi-storey and open car park areas, lush gardens, landscaped water garden, surau, water taxis jetty, man-made beach and boardwalk, refuse centre, and north water body reclamation area. An additional 3,041 trees are planned for planting.

Upon completion, Gurney Bay will transform Gurney Drive into a premier waterfront destination, offering a harmonious blend of natural beauty, green spaces, and modern amenities for both locals and tourists. The park is slated for completion by 2025.

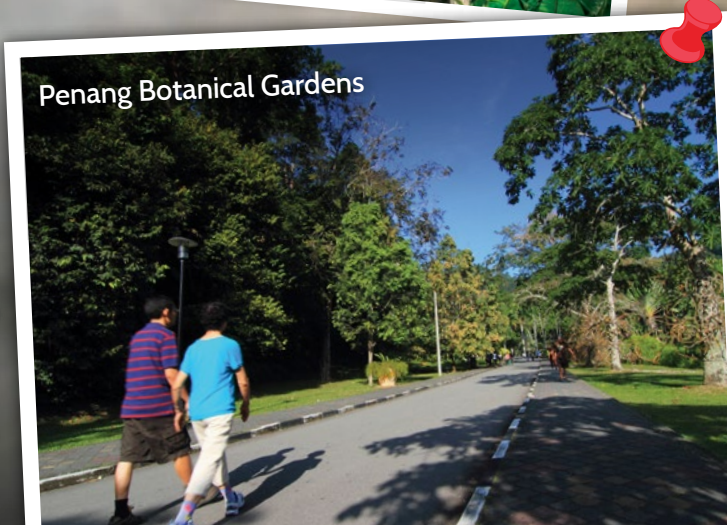
Dr. Mary Ann Harris, the executive director of PMED, notes that its members have been proactive in expanding their infrastructure,
